

EVERGREEN IS HERE!

The Grand Rapids Public Library (GRPL) is now using a new catalog system called Evergreen. This change affects some of the current library practices in place, including the placement of holds and the payment of library fines. The following information will help identify how the change might affect you.

If you are a Kent District Library (KDL) cardholder:

- You may still borrow materials from GRPL or any other Lakeland library location (visit www.llcoop.org for a list of Lakeland locations).
- GRPL items will no longer appear in the Lakeland Library catalog. However, you can still find items owned by GRPL by selecting the Evergreen icon in the Lakeland catalog.
- You may place holds on items in the Evergreen catalog. However, these items will have to be picked up at a GRPL location.
- You can return GRPL items to KDL or any Lakeland library but the items will not be checked in until they reach a GRPL location. It is strongly recommended that GRPL items be returned to a GRPL location to avoid unnecessary late fees.
- If you lose your KDL library card you can replace it at any KDL branch. GRPL cannot issue a replacement or temporary card and will not check out items to you unless you have a card.

If you are a Grand Rapids Public Library (GRPL) cardholder:

(All GRPL cards feature the GRPL name and/or logo on the front)

- You may still borrow materials from KDL or any other Lakeland library location (visit www.llcoop.org for a list of Lakeland locations).
- Items owned by KDL and other Lakeland libraries will not appear in GRPL's Evergreen catalog. However, you can still view items owned by other Lakeland libraries by selecting the Lakeland icon in the Evergreen catalog.
- You may place holds on items in the Lakeland catalog. However, these items will have to be picked up at a KDL or other Lakeland library location.
- You can return KDL items to a GRPL location but the items will not be checked in until they reach a KDL location. It is strongly recommended that KDL items be returned to a KDL location to avoid unnecessary late fees.
- If you lose your GRPL library card, you will need to replace it at a GRPL location. KDL cannot issue a replacement or temporary card and will not check out items to you or allow access to the Internet unless you have a GRPL card.

Fines and Renewals:

- Fines for overdue KDL items may be paid at any KDL branch, Lakeland library other than GRPL, or online through the Lakeland catalog. Fines for overdue GRPL items must be paid at a GRPL branch or online through the Evergreen catalog.
- KDL items may be renewed through the Lakeland online or telephone renewal system. GRPL items must be renewed through GRPL's online or telephone renewal system.
