The new branch, located in Kelloggsville High School (4787 Division Ave. S, Grand Rapids, MI 49548), opened in January. KDL has partnered with [Kelloggsville Public Schools](#) to transform the high school's state-of-the-art media center into a community library. This branch highlights Kent District Library's goal to challenge the traditional concept of what a library is and to ensure its many programs are available to everyone in the county.

- Three evenings a week between 3 to 8 PM during the school year
- Every other Saturday from 9:30 AM to 1:30 PM during the school year
- Additional hours during summer months when school is not in session, including evening and weekend hours

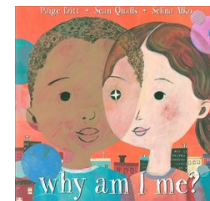

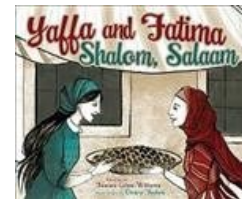

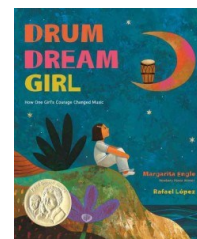
## Recommended Reads: Diverse Picture Books
