- Additional hours during summer months when school is not in session, including evening and weekend hours

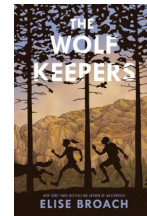

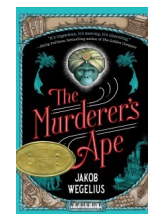
## Recommended Reads: Mysteries
